

Are you a "Master" or an "Artisan"?

Use this flowchart to determine whether your entry belongs in an Artisan category or a Master category. The choice is determined by the eligibility of the "maker," the person who constructed the quilt top. Open and Non-Judged categories are open to all entrants, regardless of Master or Artisan eligibility.

You are a quilter (long-arm or otherwise) or a maker of wearable art and **you sell/accept payment for your work** OR have done so in the past.

You have received payment to teach quilting or wearable art or have done so in the past.

You have ever had a quilt compete in the Master division of a GCQG Quilt Show, or have been classified as a "Master" or "Professional" at a different judged show in the past.

You have published a quilt or wearable art book or pattern.

YES

Since becoming a quilt maker, you have won a first place ribbon in **any** judged quilt competition.

You have won "Best of Show" in any judged quilt show.

You have had a quilt or garment juried into a national quilt show (Ex: Paducah, IQA, AQS)

If you answered "NO" to all of the above questions, you are categorized as an **ARTISAN**.

If you answered "YES" to any of the above questions, you are a **MASTER**.
