



Quilt Block Directions Jelly Roll Friendly House

Completed block size (including seam allowance) is 10.5" x 12.5."
Please DO NOT "square up" the blocks! Use ¼" seam allowance.

Cut Two: 2.5" x 2.5" squares for sky (blue, please)

Cut One: 2.5" x 6.5" rectangle for roof

Cut One: 2.5" x 6.5" rectangle for door (no vertical stripes, please)

Cut One: 2.5" x 2.5" square and two 2.5" x 6.5" rectangles for house

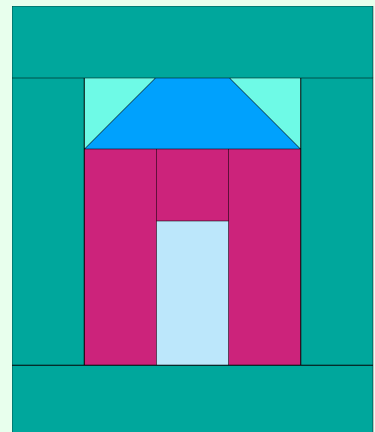
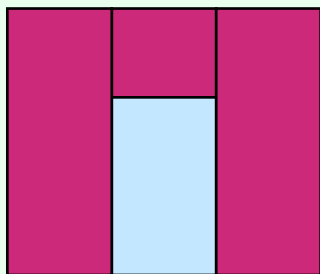
Cut Two: 2.5" x 8.5" rectangles for frame sides

Cut Two: 2.5" x 10.5" rectangles for frame top and bottom

Draw a diagonal line on the 2.5" sky squares. Sew a sky square on the diagonal to each side of the 2.5" x 6.5" roof rectangle, aligning the bottom and side of the square with the rectangle. Press squares up into triangles. Trim extra fabric behind each triangle.



Sew the 2.5" square house piece to the top of the 2.5" x 6.5" door. Press. Sew one of the 2.5" x 6.5" house pieces to each side of the door unit. Press.



Sew the roof unit to the top of the house unit. Press.

Sew the side and frame pieces to the house and roof unit. Press. Sew the top and bottom frame pieces to the block. Press.
